By Order No. 2316, served February 24, 1982, the Commission instituted the above-captioned investigation, scheduled for public hearing to commence March 23, 1982. In that order the Commission delineated 18 passenger complaints of taxicab fare overcharges lodged against Isaac Sowemimo. On February 26, 1982, the Commission received another complaint which will be added to those set forth in Order No. 2316, thus amending that order. The particulars of the most recent complaint are as follows:

19. IC (Informal Complaint) # 6050 - On February 2, 1982, an unlawful charge of \$18.60 for the transportation of one passenger from Washington National Airport to Huntington Parkway, Bethesda, Md. (\$12.80).


The fares for trips originating at Washington National Airport of one party include a \$.50 gate fee passed on to passengers.

Also, in Order No. 2316 the complaint listed at No. 14 should be I.C. # 5034 rather than # 5032.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the complaints listed in Order No. 2316 be supplemented by adding Informal Complaint # 6050 as set forth above.
2. That Item Number 14 in Order No. 2316 be amended to read I.C. # 5034.
3. That in all other respects, Order No. 2316 shall remain fully effective.
