

Previously, Order Nos. 2344 and 2357 were served in this case on June 9 and August 11, 1982, respectively. Those orders are incorporated by reference herein.

On August 16, 1982, a letter was received from Metro-Area Sightseeing Tours stating, inter alia, "[w]e are hereby voluntarily (sic) revoking our business - so please cancel our Certificate No. 36" Inasmuch as this carrier has not been providing service to the public as authorized by its certificate, revocation is in the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 36 issued to Metro-Area Sightseeing Tours is hereby revoked.
