By Order No. 2433, served June 9, 1983, and incorporated by reference herein, applicant's request for temporary authority was denied. On June 13, 1983, Congressional Tours, Inc., filed an application (styled motion) for reconsideration, asking that temporary authority be granted based on the evidence presented on June 9, 1983, at the public hearing on applicant's request for corresponding permanent authority. \*/

Having reviewed the evidence as requested, we find that the criteria of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(d)(3) of the Compact are satisfied to an extent permitting the grant of temporary authority set forth below. An appropriate tariff and certificate of insurance have been filed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Congressional Tours, Inc., is hereby granted temporary authority to engage in charter operations between points in the Metropolitan District commencing June 15, 1983, and ending June 20, 1983, at 11:59 p.m.


2. That Congressional Tours, Inc., is hereby granted temporary authority to engage in special operations between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to sightseeing tours, commencing June 15, 1983, at 11:59 p.m., unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

3. That Congressional Tours, Inc., is hereby directed to identify its motor vehicle as required by Commission Regulation No. 68-03 and to file an affidavit evidencing compliance with said regulation no later than June 17, 1983.
