
THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case No. AP-83-48 of VIP Coach Services, Inc., is hereby rescheduled to commence Wednesday, November 16, 1983, at 9:30 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D. C. 20006, and to continue from day to day thereafter until completed.
2. That applicant publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, and post continually and conspicuously in each of its vehicles through the date of public hearing, notice of this application and hearing, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Friday, September 30, 1983, and present at the hearing an affidavit of publication from the selected newspaper.
3. That any person desiring to protest the application (except those who have already filed a protest herein) shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Monday, October 17, 1983, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or notice on counsel for applicant, Lawrence E. Lindeman, Esquire, at the address given above.
4. That applicant is hereby assessed \$1,500 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, and is directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, Suite 316,

1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D. C. 20006, no later than Wednesday, October 26, 1983.

5. That applicant file with the Commission no later than October 26, 1983, four copies each of a statement of projected revenue and revenue deductions anticipated from its first 12-month period of operations, a current operating statement and a complete balance sheet, simultaneously serve one copy of each statement on each party of record as of October 17, 1983, and produce the originals thereof at the public hearing.
