
By Order No. 2466, served September 13, 1983, the Commission, inter alia, scheduled the above-captioned application for public hearing on October 27, 1983.

On October 24, 1983, applicant filed a motion to postpone the hearing "preferably until early December." In support of the motion, applicant states that more time is needed for interviewing prospective witnesses.

Also, in the motion, applicant indicates he has asked one of these witnesses to represent him at the hearing, "in accordance with Rule 3-03." The individual in question has advised members of the Commission's staff that he is not an attorney. This raises a question whether such representation is permitted by the Commission rules, and this question will be submitted to the Commission for determination.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the public hearing in Case No. AP-83-51 is hereby postponed until further order of the Commission.
