By Order No. 2477, served September 28, 1983, applicant was issued certain temporary authority effective October 1, 1983, to remain in effect through February 29, 1984. That grant consumed 152 of the 180 days temporary authority permitted by the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(d)(3).


Applicant also filed and prosecuted its application in Case No. AP-83-50 for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to conduct operations similar to those authorized under temporary authority. That case is currently pending.

By motion filed February 3, 1984, applicant seeks an extension of its temporary authority through the remaining 28-day limit, "to ensure a continuation of a needed service to the public under Frederick Limousine's temporary authority."

The criteria for issuance of 180 days temporary authority having already been met in Case No. AP-83-49, the Commission finds that a grant of the requested extension will contribute to the orderly processing of Case No. AP-83-50. The temporary authority granted by Order No. 2477 will be extended through March 28, 1984.
