By Order No. 2572, served June 27, 1984, and incorporated herein by reference, it was noted that Airline Baggage & Crew Transfer, Inc., ("respondent") had filed correspondence indicating that it had never commenced the contract service authorized by its SP-98-01. Accordingly, this dormancy investigation was instituted and respondent was directed to show cause why Authorization No. SP-98-01 should not be revoked. Respondent was also directed to request an oral hearing if it wanted one.

The 30 days given to show cause or request oral hearing expired. No filing or other communication was received from respondent. Accordingly, Authorization No. SP-98-01 shall be revoked for dormancy.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that Authorization No. SP-98-01 issued to Airline Baggage & Crew Transfer, Inc., is hereby revoked.
