
By motion filed December 11, 1984, International Limousine Service, Inc., ("ILS" or "applicant") seeks to proceed under Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure No. 22-01 and in connection therewith waives its right to public hearing. Applicant states that it published notice of its application as directed by Order No. 2627 */ and that no protests have been filed within the time established therefor. Applicant further states that it shall file affidavits and a proposed order in this matter "[i]n the next few days. . . ."

Upon consideration of ILS's motion and affidavit of publication filed November 27, 1984, a copy of which was appended to the motion, the hearing set for December 13, 1984, shall be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the hearing scheduled by Order 2627 to commence December 13, 1984, is hereby cancelled.
2. That the obligation of International Limousine Service, Inc., to prepay the amount of \$500.00 preliminarily estimated to cover hearing expenses is hereby suspended pending further order of the Commission.
3. That applicant is hereby directed to file an affidavit of posting as described in Order No. 2627, on or before December 30, 1984.
4. That International Limousine Service, Inc., is hereby directed to file all additional items to be considered by the Commission when ruling on applicant's motion no later than December 30, 1984.
