By application filed February 1, 1985, Georgetown University trading as Georgetown University Transportation Society ("GUTS" or "applicant") seeks authority to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 56 to change Route 5, a regular route operating over described streets in the District of Columbia between the university's main campus and law center.

Two routings described in applicant's Certificate No. 26 would be affected, Routes 5a and 5b. However, the changes to both routes would be the same. The existing description of the routing to be affected is as follows:

(Eastbound) ". . .over Constitution Avenue to Louisiana Avenue, then over Louisiana Avenue to North Capitol Street. . . ."

(Westbound) ". . .over Constitution Avenue to Virginia Avenue"

The proposed routing would be:

(Eastbound) ". . .over Constitution Avenue to 6th Street, then over 6th Street to G Street, then over G Street to 7th Street, then over 7th Street to H Street, then over H Street Massachusetts Avenue, then over Massachusetts Avenue to North Capitol Street. . . ."

(Westbound) ". . .over Constitution Avenue to Pennsylvania Avenue, then over Pennsylvania Avenue to 6th Street, then over 6th Street to G Street, then over G Street to 7th Street, then over Constitution Avenue to Virginia Avenue. . . ."

The purpose of the proposed change is to serve law center facilities at 605 G Street N.W., used by twenty employees and 50-60 students at any one time and as late as 9 p.m.

This matter must be scheduled for public hearing. Applicant will be directed to publish notice of this application and the hearing scheduled thereon.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-captioned matter is hereby scheduled for public hearing to commence at 9:30 a.m., on Thursday, March 14, 1985, in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Room 314, Washington, D.C. 20006;


2. That applicant is directed to publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Georgetown University community, notice of the application and hearing, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Tuesday, February 19, 1985.

3. That applicant is directed to post in each of its vehicles operating over the affected route, continuously and conspicuously through the date of the public hearing, notice of said application and hearing, in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Tuesday, February 19, 1985.

4. That applicant shall submit affidavits attesting such publication and posting, no later than March 4, 1985.

5. That any person desiring to protest this application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14, or any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission in writing, no later than Monday, March 4, 1985, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to Robert P. Watkins, Esquire, Williams & Connolly, 839 - 17th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006.
