By motion (letter) filed May 8, 1985, Rodgers E. Johnson trading as J & J Bus Service ("respondent") requests that the Commission waive hearing in the above-captioned case, and accept for filing an application to amend routes and an application of J & J Bus Service, Inc., to acquire control of respondent. In addition to the applications, respondents filed a ridership survey for the period April 29 - May 3, 1985, and an affidavit of identification of vehicles being currently operated.


In support of this motion respondent cites his inability to pay hearing costs due to a loss his company sustained in the last six months of 1984 which required that he obtain an extension of credit from existing creditors.

On May 24, 1985, respondent filed an affidavit of publication and posting. Official notice of the Commission's records indicates that no protests were filed within the time set therefor.

Pursuant to Regulation No. 15-04, the motion shall be referred to the Commission for disposition. Pending that disposition, the public hearing scheduled for May 30, 1985, shall be cancelled, and the requirement that respondent pay a hearing assessment shall be suspended.
