By motion filed June 3, 1985, Clarence B. Nelson trading as Mini-Bus Limousine and School Bus Service seeks an extension of time to June 5, 1985, in which to file a corrected balance sheet and current operating statement pursuant to the terms of Order No. 2696, served April 16, 1985. As reason for the request Mr. Nelson by his attorney states that a final review of those updated materials indicated some errors requiring recalculation and reparation of the financial forms.

It appearing that no party will be prejudiced by granting the relatively brief extension requested inasmuch as the financial information at issue will be made available more than a week prior to the hearing, and it further appearing that good cause for granting the motion has been shown in that the delayed financial information may be more accurate than information available for filing on June 3, 1985, the motion shall be granted.
