

By Order No. 2713, served June 7, 1985, and incorporated herein by reference, the above-captioned investigation was instituted pursuant to Title II, Article II, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether Special Authorization Nos. 97 and 102 of Washington Motor Coach Company, Inc., and Lawson Transportation Corporation, respectively, should be revoked.
