

By motion filed June 19, 1985, Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation requests that the hearing in the above-captioned matter now scheduled to commence Wednesday, June 26, 1985, be continued. As reason for the request counsel for Ironsides states that he will be out of the local area for the week of June 24-28, 1985. Counsel requests that the hearing be rescheduled at the Commission's earliest convenience. Counsel for the Commission staff does not oppose the motion.
