By motion filed October 1, 1985, American Coach Lines, Inc. ("ACL"), applicant in this case, requests that the Commission continue to December 3, 1985, the public hearing in the above-captioned matter currently scheduled to commence November 7, 1985. In support of its motion ACL states that two of the principal operating witnesses intending to appear on applicant's behalf will be out of the country on November 7, 1985, on a previously scheduled trip which cannot be rescheduled. Applicant's attorney was informed of this fact after the Commission issued Order No. 2766, served September 17, 1985, establishing the November 7 hearing date. No formal protests have been filed. Counsel for the Commission supports the motion provided applicant consents to an enlarged briefing period, a condition to which ACL's attorney has agreed.

Good cause having been shown, the motion shall be granted.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the motion of American Coach Lines, Inc., is hereby granted.
2. That the hearing scheduled for November 7, 1985, in the above-captioned matter is hereby cancelled.
3. That the application of American Coach Lines, Inc., is hereby scheduled for public hearing to commence Tuesday, December 3, 1985, at 9:30 a.m., in Room 314, 1625 I Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006, and to continue from day to day thereafter until completed.
4. That American Coach Lines, Inc., is hereby relieved of its obligation to deliver \$1,000 to the offices of the Commission no later than October 28, 1985.
5. That American Coach Lines, Inc., is hereby directed to deliver \$1,000, an amount preliminarily estimated to cover hearing

costs pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact, to the office of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Suite 316, Washington, D.C. 20006, no later than Friday, November 22, 1985.

6. That in all other respects the requirements of Order No. 2766, served September 17, 1985, remain unchanged.
