
By application filed November 6, 1985, PTA, Inc., trading as Personal Transportation Assurance, seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to conduct charter and special operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

By letter dated November 8, 1985, applicant's president advised that applicant was concluding certain business negotiations and asked for a hearing date "around February 1986." On February 6, 1986, the Commission's General Counsel wrote applicant's president asking applicant to advise by February 21, 1986, whether it wanted to withdraw the application or have it set for hearing. Applicant telephoned and was directed to file a written response. As of this date the record shows applicant has filed no response.

This application will be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute.
