
Among other things, Order No. 2832, served March 5, 1986, directed applicant to comply with certain requirements of that order by April 4, 1986. By motion filed March 31, 1986, applicant seeks a 45 day extension of the compliance date to May 19, 1986.

In order to comply with the requirements of Order No. 2832, applicant would have to be in possession of the specialty vehicles in which it was authorized to provide service. In support of its motion applicant states that the vehicles are unique and must be specially ordered to applicant's specifications. Applicant says it would be unable to finalize the purchase order sooner than expiration of the reconsideration period or determination of any application for reconsideration. Because of the significant cost of such a fleet, applicant wants to be assured its project will go forward.

For good cause shown, the motion shall be ganted.
