By application filed April 15, 1986, and supplemented April 21, 1986, DSR International, Inc. ("transferor"), seeks Commission approval pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(h), to transfer its Authorization Nos. SP-115-01, SP-115-02, SP-115-03, and SP-115-05 to DSR Dynamic, Inc. ("transferee"), a District of Columbia corporation.

These authorizations, issued to transferor pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 70, authorize charter operations pursuant to contracts between transferor and the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS); the United States Department of Health and Human Services, National Institutes of Health (NIH); and the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Public Health Service (PHS).

Transferor states that it has been conducting its transportation business as part of a joint venture with Dynamic Travel Services, Inc. When it appeared that their transportation business would be on a long term basis, they formed a new corporation, transferee DSR Dynamic, Inc., owned 50 percent by transferor DSR International, Inc., and 50 percent by Dynamic Travel Services, Inc.

The application contains a balance sheet for transferee as of December 31, 1985, together with supporting schedules. There is also an operating statement and supporting schedules for the year ended December 31, 1985.

The application also contains copies of letters to the contracting officers of the government agencies involved asking that the contracts be amended to be in the name of DSR Dynamic, Inc.

Transferee will be made a party respondent. Applicant transferor will be required to publish notice of its application, and a date will be established for the filing of protests, if any.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That DSR Dynamic, Inc., is hereby made a party respondent to this case.

2. That DSR International, Inc., is directed to publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, notice of this application in a form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Friday, May 2, 1986.

3. That DSR International, Inc., shall file with the Commission an affidavit of such publication, no later than Friday, May 23, 1986.

4. That any person desiring to protest this application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule 14, or any person desiring a hearing on this matter, including the parties hereto, shall so notify the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., #316, Washington, D.C. 20006 in writing, no later than Friday, May 23, 1986, and shall mail a copy of such protest or notice to DSR International, Inc., 910 - 16th Street, N.W., #404, Washington, D.C. 20006.
