
By Order No. 2842, served March 31, 1986, Capitol Bus Rental, Inc. ("applicant"), was directed to comply with five requirements specified therein, within 30 days. As of April 29, 1986, applicant had met all of the requirements except the filing of an affidavit that its vehicles were identified in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 70-10.

On April 29, 1986, counsel for applicant filed a motion seeking a fourteen day extension until May 14, 1986, to meet the identification requirement. The motion states that applicant is awaiting receipt of its identification decals and will have them installed by that date.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED

1. That applicant shall identify its vehicles in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 70-10 and shall file an affidavit of such identification with the Commission no later than May 14, 1986.
2. That unless applicant complies with the requirements of the preceding paragraph on or before May 14, 1986, the application shall stand denied in its entirety, effective upon the expiration of the said compliance time.
3. That except to the extent modified herein, Order No. 2842, served March 31, 1986, remains in full force.
