
On August 12, 1986, Georgetown University, trading as Georgetown University Transportation Society ("applicant"), filed a Motion to Waive Public Hearing and Proceed Under Shortened Proceedings in which it asked that the Commission cancel the public hearing scheduled for August 21, 1986, and decide this matter pursuant to Commission Rule No. 22 on the basis of the pleadings, including the evidence tendered with the motion.

In support of this motion, applicant states that notice of the application and hearing was duly published and posted in its vehicles as required by Order No. 2885 served July 17, 1986. No protests were filed within the time set therefor.

The motion and the case shall be referred to the Commission for disposition. Pending that disposition, the public hearing scheduled for August 21, 1986, shall be cancelled.
