By Order No. 2920, served October 9, 1986, the Commission approved the issuance of temporary authority to Coleman, conditioned upon Coleman's filing within 30 days of the date of that order: (1) a certificate of insurance in conformance with Regulation No. 62; (2) two copies of its WMATC tariff as described in its application in conformance with Regulation No. 55; (3) an equipment list specifying make, model, serial number, vehicle identification number, license plate number and jurisdiction for each vehicle to be used in WMATC operations; (4) proof that all vehicles to be used in WMATC operations are registered with and have been inspected by a Signatory jurisdiction to the Compact; (5) an affidavit of vehicle identification in conformance with Regulation No. 68.

Coleman complied with none of these requirements. On November 7, 1986, counsel for Coleman requested an extension of 30 days for the filing of the required insurance certificate, asserting that the fault for failure to file such certificate lies with the insurance company, not applicant. The requested extension will be granted to cover all of the above-listed requirements, thus preserving Coleman's eligibility to secure temporary authority upon timely compliance on or before December 8, 1986.
