By Order No. 2931, served November 25, 1986, the Commission instituted an investigation pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 of Gaithersburg Limousine Service, Inc. ("GLS" or "respondent"), should be revoked. The reason for initiating the investigation was GLS's failure to file a certificate of insurance evidencing either new insurance or reinstatement of existing insurance for which the Commission had received notice of cancellation effective 12:01 a.m., November 25, 1986. Absence of a valid insurance certificate is a violation of Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact. Accordingly, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 was suspended by Order No. 2931, and GLS was directed by that order to comply within 30 days with Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 62, as amended by Order No. 2721, served June 19, 1985. Respondent was further directed to file either a request for hearing or an appropriate certificate of insurance or any other evidence within the 30-day period to show good cause why Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence elapsed on December 29, 1986, without a filing of any type by GLS. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 will be revoked for wilful failure to comply with both a lawful order and a lawful regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 of Gaithersburg Limousine Service, Inc., is hereby revoked.
