

The certificate of insurance on file for Congressional Tours, Inc., expired March 22, 1987. By Order No. 2989, served March 26, 1987, and incorporated herein by reference, Congressional's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 94 was suspended. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) to determine whether Certificate No. 94 should be revoked. Congressional was directed within 30 days to comply with the Commission's insurance requirements or otherwise show cause why its Certificate No. 94 should not be revoked. Congressional made no response to Order No. 2989.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 94 issued to Congressional Tours, Inc., is hereby revoked for failure to comply with a lawful order of the Commission.
