

By motion (letter) filed May 6, 1987, Melvin Myles trading as H&M Bus Service requests, through his attorney, that the above-captioned application be withdrawn. */ Advanced as reason for this request is the fact that, subsequent to the filing of the application, another carrier commenced operations over the route in question, causing Mr. Myles to have serious questions concerning the financial viability of the proposed operations. Applicant feels these questions must be addressed before proceeding. The motion to withdraw is hereby granted, and Case No. AP-87-04 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
