

By application filed April 20, 1987, American Coach Lines, Inc., filed a proposed WMATC Tariff No. 7 to cancel its Tariff No. 6. The proposed tariff would increase rates for per-capita sightseeing tours and would eliminate volume discounts on such tours for prearranged groups.

On April 23, 1987, the Commission's Executive Director wrote to counsel for applicant requesting certain financial data in support of the proposed increases. The supporting material has not been filed. In order to provide sufficient time for orderly review of the tariff and supporting materials, it is necessary to suspend the tariff.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that proposed WMATC Tariff No. 7, filed by American Coach Lines, Inc., is hereby suspended effective May 20, 1987, pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 6.
