By Order No. 2999, served April 16, 1987, the Commission instituted an investigation pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether the temporary authority issued to Nigussie Kassa and Anna Michael trading as Lion Transportation should be revoked. The Commission instituted the investigation in response to a letter dated April 13, 1987, from Lion's insurance broker. The letter advised the Commission that Lion's insurance policy, which had an expiration date of January 22, 1988, had been cancelled at the request of Lion Transportation on March 11, 1987.

Lion was directed within 30 days from institution of the investigation to file an appropriate certificate or reinstatement of insurance or otherwise show cause why its temporary authority should not be revoked. Lion Transportation made no response to Order No. 2999.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the temporary authority conditionally issued by Order No. 2949, served December 12, 1986, and subsequently made effective by Commission letter dated January 29, 1987, is hereby revoked for failure to comply with Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 62.
