

By Order No. 3039, served June 16, 1987, and incorporated herein by reference, this investigation was instituted for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 90 should be revoked. The Commission had been informed by letter that Mr. Dickens is deceased and that his insurance coverage had been cancelled. Certificate No. 90 was thereafter suspended, and 30 days were provided to show cause why it should not be revoked. No response was made to Order No. 3039.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 90 issued to James Warren Dickens is hereby revoked for dormancy.
