
By Order No. 3044, served July 2, 1987, On-Time American Transport, Inc. ("applicant"), was directed to comply with six requirements specified therein by August 3, 1987. On August 3, 1987, counsel for applicant filed a motion seeking a 30-day extension of the compliance date.

The motion states that applicant had difficulty in obtaining insurance and did not receive proper insurance coverage until July 28, 1987. Applicant is presently awaiting assignment of a specific insurance carrier and requests an extension until September 2, 1987, so it can have ample time to file an appropriate certificate of insurance once the assignment is made.

For good cause shown, the motion shall be granted.
