By application filed August 14, 1987, International Limousine Service, Inc. ("ILS" or "applicant"), seeks Commission approval of its WMATC Tariff No. 11. This tariff is a three-year contract -- not eligible under Regulation No. 70 -- between ILS and 1250 Twenty Fourth Street Associates Limited Partnership for a shuttle service operating Monday through Friday from 7:30 to 9:30 a.m. and from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m., serving the following locations:

1250 - 24th Street, N.W.
2300 N Street, N.W.
2300 M Street, N.W.
Dupont Circle and Foggy Bottom Metro Stations


ILS already holds operating authority sufficient to cover this operation in its Certificate No. 38. Applicant's reason for filing this contract as a separate tariff is that it contains negotiated rates different from those in its general tariff. This requires Commission approval.

ILS has supplied a statement of its contract rates, its general tariff rates, and its rationale for the differences. It has also submitted a projection of income and expenses attributable to the proposed service. We have examined this evidence, and we shall approve the tariff.

Finally, applicant moves the Commission to approve the proposed tariff on less than 30 days' notice so that service can commence on September 8, 1987. This requires an order of the Commission pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 5(e). By this order we shall grant the motion.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that WMATC Tariff No. 11 of International Limousine Service, Inc., is approved to become effective September 8, 1987.
