By Order No. 3049, served July 21, 1987, the Commission instituted an investigation pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 114 should be revoked. The investigation was instituted after the Commission received letters from both Odyssey Vans, Inc., and its insurance broker that the insurance policy on file with the Commission would not be renewed upon its August 1, 1987, expiration date.

Accordingly, Order No. 3049 suspended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 114 effective August 1, 1987, and Odyssey Vans, Inc. ("Odyssey"), was directed to comply with Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 62 within 30 days from the service date of the order. Odyssey was further directed to file within the same 30-day period an appropriate certificate or reinstatement of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 114 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence elapsed on August 20, 1987, without a filing of any type by Odyssey. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 114 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 114 of Odyssey Vans, Inc., is hereby revoked.
