

The certificate of insurance on file for Arrowhead Bus & Limousine Equipment, Inc., expired August 17, 1987. By Order No. 3059, served August 17, 1987, and incorporated herein by reference, Arrowhead's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 75 was suspended. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) to determine whether Certificate No. 75 should be revoked. Arrowhead was directed within 30 days to comply with Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 62. Arrowhead was further directed to file within the same 30-day period an appropriate certificate of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 75 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence elapsed on September 16, 1987, without a filing of any type by Arrowhead. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 75 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 75 of Arrowhead Bus & Limousine Equipment, Inc., is hereby revoked.
