

By Order No. 3075, served September 29, 1987, Rosetta D. Murray trading as Murray's Non-Emergency Transport Service ("applicant") was directed to file, among other things, an affidavit of identification, registration data, and a certificate of inspection for vehicles to be used in the WMATC operations proposed under this application. By motion filed October 19, 1987, applicant seeks an extension of time to comply with the aforementioned requirements. The motion states that a 21-passenger vehicle with a storage compartment is on order with an expected delivery date of October 26, 1987.

Certainly, applicant is precluded from complying with specific identification and inspection requirements until she takes delivery of the vehicle. For good cause shown, the time for compliance with Order No. 3075 is hereby extended to Thursday, October 29, 1987.
