

The certificate of insurance on file for Gaithersburg Limousine Service, Inc., expired January 16, 1988. By Order No. 3117, served January 20, 1988, and incorporated herein by reference, Gaithersburg's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 was suspended. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) to determine whether Certificate No. 106 should be revoked. Gaithersburg was directed within 30 days to comply with Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 62. Gaithersburg was further directed to file within the same 30-day period an appropriate certificate of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence elapsed on February 19, 1988, without a filing of any type by Gaithersburg. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 106 of Gaithersburg Limousine Service, Inc., is hereby revoked.
