Case No. MP-88-03

By motion filed March 30, 1988, Medico Transportation Services, Inc. ("Medico"), requests an opportunity for oral hearing pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) and as provided by Order No. 3127, served February 29, 1988. The purpose of the hearing would be to show cause why Medico's Certificate No. 51 should not be revoked.

This case was instituted by Order No. 3127, when it appeared that Medico might be in violation of Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) pertaining to maintenance of adequate insurance for the protection of the public. Order No. 3127 suspended Medico's Certificate No. 51. Medico states that it has complied with Order No. 3127 by ceasing all operations within the Metropolitan District. Medico requests additional time before revocation action is taken to give Medico an opportunity either to complete negotiations for the sale of Certificate No. 51 to an interested party or, in the alternative, to arrange for the issuance of a certificate of insurance.

Accordingly, this matter will be set for public hearing pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g). At the hearing Medico will be expected to show cause why its certificate should not be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That a public hearing in Case No. MP-88-03 is hereby scheduled to commence Tuesday, May 17, 1988, at 9:30 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Room 314, Washington, D.C. 20006.

2. That Medico Transportation Services, Inc., is hereby directed to publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than Monday, April 18, 1988, notice of this matter and the hearing thereon in the form prescribed by the Commission Staff and present at the hearing an affidavit of publication.

3. That any person desiring to protest this matter shall do so in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14 and any person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Friday, May 6, 1988, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of said protest or notice on Joel C. Weingarten, Esq., 51 Monroe Street, Suite 1500, Rockville, Md. 20850.

4. That Medico Transportation Services, Inc., is hereby assessed \$450 pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 19 of the Compact and is directed to deliver said amount to the offices of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N.W., Suite 316, Washington, D.C. 20006, no later than Friday, May 6, 1988.
