
By motion filed November 21, 1988, Mizell Travel Agency, Inc. (Mizell), seeks an extension of time in which to comply with the requirements of Order No. 3241, served October 24, 1988. Order No. 3241 requires the filing of the following by Mizell: (a) two copies of its revised WMATC Tariff No. 1, (b) an equipment list, (c) evidence of vehicle ownership or lease, (d) a certificate of insurance, and (e) an affidavit of identification of vehicles.

Mizell requests a 60-day extension of time from November 23, 1988, to January 23, 1989. The request for additional compliance time was made due to an unexpected disruption of business caused by an accelerated request to vacate its offices. Mizell does not expect to be fully settled in its new facilities until the beginning of next year.

Good cause having been shown, the motion to extend compliance time is hereby granted.
