By Order No. 3288, served February 8, 1989, this application was conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's compliance with the requirements of that order by March 25, 1989. Some of the requirements had to do with applicant's vehicles.

By motion filed March 6, 1989, applicant requests a 30-day extension of time to comply with the requirements of Order No. 3288. Applicant states that the "reason for the request is the delay in receiving two vans for the initial start up of Mercy Ambulette Services, Incorporated. The projected date for receiving and registering these vans is mid April."


For good cause shown, the motion will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That unless Mercy Ambulette Services, Inc., complies with the requirements of Order No. 3288 on or before April 25, 1989, or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow, the grant of authority therein shall be void, and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of the said compliance time.

2. That in all other respects, Order No. 3288 remains in full force and effect.
