By letter dated January 13, 1989, and filed January 24, 1989, All About Town, Inc. (AAT), requested a postponement or suspension of the hearing in the above-captioned cases scheduled by Order No. 3273, served January 11, 1989, to commence February 16, 1989. The letter stated that AAT had not published notice of the hearing as directed in Order No. 3273. The letter also stated that several elements of the applications, including the schedule of equipment and the proposed tariff, need to be changed. By its terms Order No. 3273 required updated financial statements. By Order No. 3291, served February 15, 1989, the public hearing was cancelled pending further order of the Commission.

On March 20, 1989, AAT filed entirely new applications. Accordingly, the above-captioned applications are hereby dismissed.
