By Order No. 3288, served February 8, 1989, this application was conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's compliance with the requirements of that order by March 25, 1989. Some of the requirements had to do with applicant's vehicles.

By Order No. 3299, served March 7, 1989, applicant's motion was granted for an extension of time to April 25, 1989, to comply with Order No. 3288.

On April 14, 1989, applicant again requests an extension of time, with no date specified. Applicant states that the ". . . reason for the delay is the pending arrival of the two vans"


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That unless Mercy Ambulette Services, Inc., complies with the requirements of Order No. 3288 on or before June 26, 1989, or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow, the grant of authority contained therein shall be void, and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.

2. That unless applicant complies with the requirements of Order No. 3288 on or before May 26, 1989, it shall file on or before that date a complete, detailed, and notarized report of its efforts to secure vehicles, including evidence of the expected delivery date.

3. That in all other respects, Order No. 3288 remains in full force and effect.
