By Order No. 3268, served January 5, 1989, Priority One Services, Inc. (applicant), was granted 180 days temporary authority to provide certain charter service pursuant to a contract with Capitol Hill Business Association, Inc. The temporary authority became effective January 13, 1989. The contract pursuant to which the service was to be provided expired April 30, 1989, and the temporary authority was scheduled to expire the same date, thus using 108 days of the 180 days available.

On April 26, 1989, applicant filed an extension of the contract effective from May 1, 1989, through June 12, 1989, and requested an extension of its temporary authority to cover that period. This extension would bring the aggregate total to 151 days, still within the 180 days granted by Order No. 3268. Accordingly, the requested extension is granted.
