
By motion filed May 22, 1989, Dan Jenkins trading as Jenkins Transportation Service (JTS) seeks to extend by 30 days the time for compliance with the requirements of Order No. 3316, served April 18, 1989. Order No. 3316 required the filing of (a) three copies of its WMATC Tariff No. 3 reflecting all rates and regulations to be charged; (b) a certificate of insurance in accordance with WMATC Regulation No. 62; (c) an equipment list specifying make, model, serial number, and license plate number with jurisdiction for each vehicle to be used in WMATC operations; (d) an affidavit of identification of vehicles pursuant Commission Regulation No. 67; and (e) an affidavit affirming that the vehicles seating 16 passengers or more have been equipped with seat belts for all seats.

JTS complied with (a) above but seeks additional time to submit remaining documents due to an extremely busy work schedule and its involvement in another proceeding before the Commission. JTS's original time for compliance expired on May 18, 1989. The motion will, therefore, additionally be treated as a motion to file out of time. An extension of time will be granted to 30 days after the compliance date set in Order No. 3316.

The motion to file out of time and the motion to extend time for compliance are hereby granted. The time for compliance is extended to Monday, June 19, 1989.
