By Order No. 3280, served January 24, 1989, Air Couriers International Ground Transportation Services, Inc., trading as Passenger Express (transferee) was directed to file certain materials in connection with Special Authorization Nos. SP-55-01, SP-55-02, SP-55-03, SP-55-05, SP-55-06, and SP-55-08, within 60 days of the service date of Order No. 3280. On March 24, 1989, transferee filed certain materials which were determined not to meet the requirements of Order No. 3280. Accordingly, and in consonance with the terms of Order No. 3280, the above-listed Special Authorizations were deemed void and cancelled. See Order No. 3320, served April 24, 1989.

On May 24, 1989, transferee timely filed a petition for reconsideration of Order No. 3320. The petition states that transferee misunderstood the requirements of Order No. 3280 and explains the grounds for its misinterpretation. Transferee further states that it only understood what it was required to do when it received Order No. 3320. Accordingly, transferee seeks reconsideration of Order No. 3320 and asks that it be granted 60 days from the service date of that order to meet the requirements which it now understands.

We have examined transferee's rationale concerning its misunderstanding of Order No. 3280, and we find the explanation reasonable. Therefore, reconsideration of Order No. 3320 is hereby granted, and transferee is hereby granted an extension of time through June 23, 1989, to comply with the requirements of Order No. 3280.
