By application filed August 1, 1989, and supplemented August 24, 1989, Westscot Limited Partnership (Westscot or applicant) seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers in for-hire charter and special operations between the Westfields International Conference Center, 14750 Conference Center Drive, Chantilly, VA 22021, and points in the Metropolitan District. 1/2/3/

- 1/ To the extent this application could be construed to include transportation solely within the Commonwealth of Virginia, it is hereby dismissed pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 1(b).
 - 2/ This description of the authority sought represents an interpretation of applicant's proposal which is stated in the application as follows: "To provide transportation for Westfields International Conference Center guests to the Kennedy Center, the Mall, the Capital Center and other destinations of interest in the Metropolitan Area on an as needed basis." Elsewhere in the application is the statement: "Sole point of origin is the Westfields International Conference Center in Fairfax County" If the interpretation presented in the text does not correctly represent applicant's proposal, applicant is directed to file a written correction no later than ten days from the date of service of this order.
 - 3/ The address and telephone number provided for applicant ICRA Transportation Services, Inc., are the address and telephone number of the Westfields International Conference Center.

Applicant submitted the following as its proposed tariff:

Leesburg, Middleburg, Old Town (presumably Alexandria), and Mount Vernon are beyond the scope of this application. (See footnote 1.) The \$10, \$12.50, and \$15 rates are interpreted as a special operations, per-capita rates. All other rates are interpreted as exclusive use, group charter rates. Westscot's equipment list shows four 1989 10-passenger vans, one 1989 6-passenger stretch limousine, and two 1989 3-passenger limousines.

Also in support of the application Westscot has submitted a balance sheet as of December 31, 1988, and a projection of revenues and expenses for the proposed service.

Pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(b), this application will be scheduled for public hearing to determine if applicant is fit, willing, and able to perform the proposed service properly and comply with the Compact and the Commission's rules and regulations and to determine whether the public convenience and necessity require the proposed service. Applicant will be assessed an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the hearing expense applicant is required to bear pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 19.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That a public hearing in Case No. AP-89-40 is hereby scheduled to begin Thursday, October 12, 1989, at 9:30 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104.

2. That Westscot Limited Partnership shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation the Metropolitan District notice of this application and the hearing thereon in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission, no later than Tuesday, September 12, 1989, and shall present at the hearing an affidavit of such publication.

3. That any person wanting to protest this application shall file a protest in accordance with Commission Rule No. 14, or any person wanting to be heard on this matter shall so notify the Commission, in writing, no later than Monday, October 2, 1989, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or notice on applicant's attorney, Christopher L. Keefer, Esquire, 8280 Greensboro Drive, Suite 900, McLean, VA 22102.

4. That Westscot Limited Partnership is hereby assessed \$350 pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 19, and is directed to deliver that amount to the office of the Commission no later than Monday, October 2, 1989.
