By motion filed July 20, 1990, Videovue International, Ltd., trading as Videovue Tours (Videovue) seeks to extend the period for compliance with Order No. 3442, served December 20, 1989. In support of its request Videovue states that it continues to have difficulties in receiving proper title for its vehicles from the Department of Motor Vehicles for the State of Maryland. The delays are complicated by the fact that Videovue's attorney is out of the country and is not expected to return until July 30, 1990. Leases required for compliance with Order No. 3442 cannot be executed until appropriate titles are issued.

Upon consideration of Videovue's motion for extension of time, it is found that good cause has been shown.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with the requirements of Order No. 3442, served December 20, 1989, is hereby extended through Monday, August 20, 1990.
