By application filed July 26, 1990, Blue Lines, Inc., seeks approval to implement Tariff No. 5 (cancels Tariff No. 4) on less than 30 days notice. This requires specific authorization by order of the Commission. See Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 5(e).

The proposed tariff would increase the company's rates for charter and special operations conducted pursuant to its Certificate No. 10. Blue Lines' annual report for 1989 shows an operating loss of \$91,011, of which \$57,220 is ascribed to WMATC operations. Under the proposed rates, Blue Lines projects that the WMATC operating deficit will be reduced to \$35,416, while the company determines what additional steps may be needed to make its operations profitable.

The proposed tariff is hereby approved to become effective as soon as practicable after the service date of this order.
