
By motion filed September 13, 1990, On-Time American Transport, Inc. (applicant), seeks a Commission order approving its WMATC Tariff No. 4 on less than 30 days notice. See Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 5(e).

The proposed tariff involves a charter operation pursuant to a contract between applicant and the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (USDA-APHIS), requiring two vehicles to conduct a scheduled shuttle service among specified government office buildings. The proposed service is authorized by applicant's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 133. However, the service was competitively bid at a rate other than applicant's general charter rate contained in its Tariff No. 3. Accordingly, the new tariff requires Commission approval. Moreover, the contract requires applicant to commence operations on October 1, 1990, a date less than 30 days from the date the tariff was filed with the Commission. Under the above-cited section of the Compact approval of a tariff on less than 30 days notice requires an order of the Commission.

Upon consideration of the record in this case, the Commission hereby approves applicant's WMATC Tariff No. 4 to become effective Monday, October 1, 1990.
