
By Order No. 3553, served September 14, 1990, the above-captioned applications were scheduled for public hearing to commence Thursday, November 8, 1990.

By motion filed October 3, 1990, Rosetta D. Murray trading as Murray's Non-Emergency Transport Service, by her attorney, asks that the hearing be rescheduled for Tuesday, November 13, 1990, or any available hearing date that does not fall on a Thursday. As reason for this request, applicant states that she intends to call a representative of the District of Columbia Medicaid program to testify regarding the above-captioned matters. However, that agency's staff meetings, which are held every Thursday, conflict with the established hearing date. Good cause having been shown, the motion will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the public hearing in Case Nos. AP-90-41 and AP-90-42 scheduled for Thursday, November 8, 1990, is hereby cancelled.

3. That, in all other respects, Order No. 3553 remains in full force and effect.
