
By motion filed October 1, 1990, International Limousine Service, Inc. (applicant), seeks a Commission order approving its WMATC Tariff No. 15, Supplement No. 1, on less than 30 days notice. See Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 5(e).

The proposed tariff involves a charter operation pursuant to an agreement between applicant and the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), requiring six 21-passenger vehicles conducting operations on the grounds of NIST (Gaithersburg, MD) October 15-18, 1990. The proposed service is authorized by applicant's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 38. However, the price for the service was negotiated at a rate other than applicant's general charter rate contained in its current tariff. Accordingly, the new tariff requires Commission approval. Moreover, the agreement requires applicant to commence operations on October 15, 1990, a date less than 30 days from the date the tariff was filed with the Commission. Under the above-cited section of the Compact, approval of a tariff on less than 30 days notice requires an order of the Commission.

Upon consideration of the record in this case, the Commission hereby approves applicant's WMATC Tariff No. 15, Supplement No. 1 to be effective beginning October 15, 1990, through October 18, 1990.
