
By motion filed October 17, 1990, RAPIDTRANS, Inc., seeks a 45-day extension of time for compliance with Order No. 3558, served September 17, 1990. As grounds for the motion RAPIDTRANS, Inc., states

[a]pproval of the requested extension will allow our Company to complete its leasing process and fully comply with the COMPACT requirements. Further, it is understood that granting this extension does not change the end of the 6-month operating period for RAPIDTRANS, Inc.

The motion will be granted. It is noted that Order No. 3558 confers no operating authority on RAPIDTRANS, Inc., absent full compliance with that order as evidenced by a letter from the Commission's Executive Director advising RAPIDTRANS, Inc., that it may commence operations. No such letter has been issued, and RAPIDTRANS, Inc., is encouraged to effect compliance as quickly as possible.
