

By motion filed October 22, 1990, South East Area Transit, Inc. (SEAT), seeks a 120-day extension of time for compliance with those portions of Order No. 3560, served September 21, 1990, relating to equipment. As grounds for the motion SEAT states that it is awaiting approval of certain grant and loan applications submitted to the District of Columbia's Office of Business and Economic Development and Dominion Bank of Washington, D.C. Upon approval of the applications, SEAT will use money received from the grant and loan to purchase equipment. However, because vehicles cannot be ordered until funds are committed and insurance will not be put into effect until vehicles are delivered, a rather extended compliance period is required.

Good cause having been shown, the motion for extension of time will be granted through February 18, 1991.
