The Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) mandates that no certificate of public convenience and necessity issued under Section 4 of said Article ". . . shall remain in force unless the person . . . holding such certificate complies with such reasonable regulations as the Commission shall prescribe governing the filing and approval of surety bonds, policies of insurance, [and] qualifications as a self-insurer . . . in such reasonable amount as the Commission may require . . . ." See also Commission Regulation No. 62, as amended by Order No. 2721, served June 19, 1985.

The certificate of insurance on file for Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights (Mr. Sudan) shows a policy expiration date of January 9, 1991. On December 5, 1990, the Commission advised Mr. Sudan by letter that an appropriate certificate evidencing new insurance must be filed on or before the above-specified expiration date. On January 2, 1991, Mr. Sudan filed a request for an additional 90 days from January 9, 1991, to file a certificate of insurance. In support of his request, Mr. Sudan asserts that (1) there is a dispute with the insurance company concerning the premium, (2) a request for verification of the premium has been filed with the Maryland Insurance Division, and (3) Mr. Sudan is seeking another insurance carrier.

The request will be granted. Certificate No. 145 will be suspended effective upon the expiration of the certificate of insurance now on file with the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the above-captioned proceeding is instituted pursuant to Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g) of the Compact for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 145 of Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights shall be revoked.

2. That Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is made a party respondent to the above-captioned proceeding.


3. That Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is directed fully to comply no later than Wednesday, April 10, 1991, with the provisions of the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 9(a) and Commission Regulation No. 62, and is further directed to file with the Commission by that same date an appropriate certificate of insurance or such other

evidence, in writing and under oath, as he may deem pertinent to show good cause why his Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 145 should not be revoked.

4. That effective 12:01 a.m., January 9, 1991, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 145 issued to Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is hereby suspended until further order of the Commission, and Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is directed to cease and desist from transportation subject to the Compact, until further order of the Commission.

5. That Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is hereby provided an opportunity for hearing pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XII, Section 4(g), and is directed to file within 15 days of the service date of this order an appropriate motion pursuant to Commission Rule No. 15, if he desires an oral hearing on this matter.
