By Order No. 3560, served September 21, 1990, the Commission conditionally granted the above-captioned application, provided that applicant timely file certain required materials within 30 days of that date.

On October 22, 1990, applicant sought and was granted an extension of time for compliance through February 18, 1991. On February 19, 1991, */ applicant filed another motion for another 120-day extension of time for compliance. In support of its motion, applicant submitted a letter from Mr. Victor L. Selman, Acting Chief, Neighborhood Commercial Services Division, District of Columbia Office of Business and Economic Development. The gist of Mr. Selman's letter is that funds that could eventually reach applicant through a complex chain of entities and programs has been cut off at the wellhead by a "temporary moratorium" on the disbursement of "Equity Funds" by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The motion and supporting statement make no mention of the possible extent of the "temporary moratorium," beyond the fact of applicant's requesting another 120 days to comply. Implicit in that request is that the moratorium will be lifted, the money will make its way to applicant, and applicant will effect full compliance within the time requested.

The Commission will grant the requested extension, but no more. If this extension expires without full compliance, this application will stand denied in its entirety, without prejudice to applicant's filing of a new application at such time as it may be capable of conducting operations.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the time for compliance with the requirements of Order No. 3560 is hereby extended through Wednesday, June 19, 1991.

*/ February 18, 1991, was a government holiday, and, therefore, applicant had until close of business February 19, 1991, to make this filing.

2. That unless South East Area Transit, Inc., fully complies with the requirements of Order No. 3560 on or before Wednesday, June 19, 1991, its application in Case No. AP-90-21 shall stand denied in its entirety, effective upon the expiration of the said compliance time.
